## When selecting a color for your clients, here are a few key things to consider

#### CLIENT'S SKIN TONE WITHIN

Choose a pigment that provides the right amount of contrast against their skin tone by observing our Fitzpatrick guide.

#### SKIN TYPE

Thinner or mature skin types retain pigment better than other skin types, so be conservative with your pigment choice. You can always go darker during their follow-up procedure, if needed.

#### UNDERTONE

Is your client's skin undertone warm, cool, or neutral? Remember that pigments will always heal cooler in the skin than they appear in the bottle.

#### PREVIOUS PMU

Your client's previous PMU should be faded by at least 50% before you attempt a cover-up. Are their brows looking ashy? Correct with a warm pigment.

#### NATURAL HAIR/BROW COLOR

Select a color that is suited to their natural brow or hair/roots color. If they dye their hair, take this into consideration.

#### CREATING CUSTOM BLENDS

Create a bespoke color for your client by mixing pigments. Darken any pigment by adding Bolder Brown or Ebony, or warm up any pigment using Blonde or Medium Brown.

#### LIFESTYLE

Figure out your client's ideal brow style whether it's soft and natural, bold and makeup-like, or minimally enhanced.

#### PRO TIP

It is always better to be conservative to begin and touch up if needed.
